Secretary:

Treasurer's Report:

Dana reported that the account balance is at \$12,161. Any money left in senior player accounts at the end of the year will be moved into a scholarship account which will assist families in need pay for basketball expenses.

Coaches Report:

Coach Clodi thanked everyone for their help throughout the year. All three levels have completed their community projects. We earned \$1400 working the Storm Tournament which will be put towards paying for the U. of I. summer camp.

This summer, varsity will play approximately 18 games at East and 10-12 games at Geneva. Sophomore players will have games at Wheaton North and the freshmen will play in Schaumburg. The first day of summer camp will be the last day of school, June 8th.

A new shooting machine is on Coach Clodi's wish list. Kids can keep track of their shooting percentages for the year by entering in a code on the machine. With a trade-in (trading in our old shooting machine) a new one would cost \$4350. If one is purchased kids could sign up to use the machine at designated times. Dave Griffiths moved to request that Central Boosters pay half the cost of the shooting machine. Bob Carne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The basketball coach from Purdue has given us his strength/conditioning program for work outs. After spring break, all kids not involved in a spring sport will work out on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Open gym will be on Tuesday/Thursday. Coach Clodi will let everyone know exactly what day this will begin.

Central Boosters:

Running Saints want to purchase a used Pole Vault Pit for \$10,000. Jeff Skoog moved to approve Central Boosters spending \$5000 on the purchase of a pole vault pit. Marty Craven seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Fundraisers:
